
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### Key Vocabulary and Spellings

1	incisor	Sharp teeth for cutting food
2	molar	Flat teeth for grinding food
3	canine	Pointed teeth for tearing food
4	decay	When teeth wear down or away
5	nutrients	Sources of energy from food
6	faeces	Waste left from digested food
7	oesophagus	A muscular tube connecting mouth and stomach
8	intestine	A muscular tube connecting stomach and anus
9	acid	A liquid that can break down food
10	urine	A liquid that is excreted
